Areas of Service

Park City

Sitting at the top of a seven thousand foot climb just made for driving, **Park City is a one-of-a-kind outdoor destination**. With well-known resorts and over 400 trails, the town invites you to explore Utah's beautifully wild mountains as well as the at least one hundred-fifty local bars and restaurants—and the only five diamond hotel in Utah.

Heber

Heber was settled by LDS converts from Great Britain on May 2, 1859. Originally named London, the townsite was renamed in recognition of a local leader, Heber C. Kimball. As the largest settlement in the area, Heber City was established as the county seat.

Heber City Municipal Airport, known as the Russ McDonald Field, is located south of Heber City. The 1947 airport is added to the National Plan of Integrated Airport Systems and is considered a general aviation facility.

Salt Lake City

Ogden

live due to its surprising cultural diversity and the numerous local tech startups. ***The city is particularly known for its recreational areas, including national parks***, the LDS Missionary Training Center, and Brigham Young University.

West Valley City

West Valley is a suburb of Salt Lake City and is the second largest City in Utah. The city is spread over a large area, so it is home to the USANA Amphitheater and the Maverik Sports Center.

West Jordan

West Jordan is a comfortably middle-class suburb of Salt Lake City and is the fourth largest City in Utah. Lying at the southwest end of the Salt Lake Valley, ***it's close to the Jordan River and Real Salt Lake's own Rio Tinto stadium***.
